






# ●●● Did you know that at St Joseph's School Nagambie strives to be an educating community...

## Where the teachings of Jesus are taught, modelled and lived.

We welcome students from all denominations—not just Catholic. Our religion program focuses on how we can build better relationships with others and support each other as a school and community.

## Where families and the school work in partnership sharing responsibility to educate the child

We have a 1 to 1 laptop program where the students in 3/4/5/6 have their own personal Laptop which they get to use for the duration of their time at school and 4/5/6 are able to take it home to assist with their work. The rest of the students in F/1/2 have access to a bank of iPads and laptops.

A whole school approach to reading and spelling using the world renowned THRASS approach. This approach takes the mystery out of the English language.

In our first three terms we have a 20–30 minute, student led parent–teacher–child discussion on the progress of each child. Goals are reviewed and set by students, parents and staff. No hidden surprises at report time.

Across the school we have a 15 minute reading block every morning with parents and grandparents encouraged to participate.

A Senior Performing Arts program supported by the Catholic Education Office culminating in a massed performance of combined schools in Shepparton. This includes singing and various types of dancing.

## Where an environment of trust, respect, hope and safety is built

We offer a Blueearth program, which is a holistic approach to physical wellbeing with outside coaches assisting our teachers delivering the program.

Using the Positive Behaviour Intervention Support approach, our students are supported in a nurturing, supportive environment. We make a point of using a positive approach, with an emphasis of praising your child.

## Where school life is an integral part of parish and the wider community

Students from St. Joseph's school go on to many varied secondary schools that cater for the pathway that your child may wish to pursue these include Notre Dame, Assumption College, Goulburn Valley Grammar, St. Mary's Seymour, Euroa Secondary College and Seymour College.

Town and country bus access for those who require the service.

## Where the students learn in a challenging, enjoyable and cooperative way

Across the school Sustainability Program strongly supported by a vibrant group of parents in our "Living Classroom" garden.

Intensive Bike Education Program for the senior students in Term 4.

Extensive participation in school sport activities with involvement in Football, Netball, T-Ball, Athletics, Cross Country, Swimming, Cricket at local, district and wider levels.

We have an intensive week long swimming program with the students in ability groups of no more than 10 students.

## Where the total development of each child is nurtured.

At any given time we have a ratio of one teacher/support staff to every seven students. That is very special care of your child.

We have extensive support staff available for your children. We have a regular Speech Pathologist in Sheryn Long and student support services in . As well as these great supports we are able to call on extra support from our Catholic Education Office.

Extending Mathematical Understandings offered to those students who need that little extra support.

Past students from St. Joseph's have excelled in their many endeavours in both academia, arts and sport.

Yes we have fees but the fee is upfront and no more to pay. No hidden excursion or extra event costs throughout the year. In 2018 the family fee regardless of the number of children is \$1191. Added to that for a student in Foundation to year 3 the fees are \$320 and a student in years 4, 5 and 6 is \$480 No child is refused a Catholic Education, if you find yourself in financial difficulties we can assist.
